
In 2020, CMN Hershey earned three awards - highest fundraising, highest fundraising per capita and highest percentage of increase for medium-sized CMN Hospitals.

STUDIES SELECTED FOR FUNDING INCLUDE:

- Testing of non-invasive ventilation support for premature babies
- Evaluating outcomes of neonates with opioid withdrawal syndrome
- The role of a stress-induced protein (REDD1) in early diabetes-induced eye inflammation
- A study to measure fear of food in teens and young adults with eating disorders
- How a hormone produced mainly by the kidneys causes gut issues
- The effect of pain relievers and sedatives (fentanyl and dexmedetomidine) on patients in the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit
