- **Details**
 - 2024 NCAC *OOTD* Community Walks: 9/8 Prince William, 9/14 Loudoun, 9/29 Fairfax, 10/19 Washington, D.C. (estimated 5,000+ walkers total).
 - Deadline to guarantee benefits for all NCAC *OOTD* Community Walks is August 23, 2024. Deadline to have logo printed on all NCAC *OOTD* Community Walks t-shirts is August 2, 2024.

A-2

- **Benefit** Promotional tent OR sponsorship of event area at Walk
- **Details**
 - Sponsor must notify Kelly Mahoney at kmahoney@afsp.org of intent for redemption at least 10 business days prior to the Walk to receive benefit.
 - If sponsor chooses the “promotional tent” option (not available for the D.C. Walk): AFSP will provide one tent, two tables and two chairs. Sponsor must provide all other materials.
 - If sponsor chooses the “sponsorship of event area” option: sponsor will work with NCAC to determine through which Walk event area (e.g. Loss & Healing Activity, Team Photo Area, etc.) recognition benefits will be provided. AFSP will provide sponsor signage for at that area.
 - The U.S. National Park Service does not permit sponsor promotional tents at the D.C. Walk. Therefore, only the “sponsorship of event area at Walk” benefit is available for that Walk event.

- **Benefit** Exclusive sponsorship of NCAC community-wide presentation of an AFSP educational or loss & healing program
- **Details**
 - Sponsor will work with NCAC to determine through which community-wide program (e.g. [Talk Saves Lives™](#), [Survivor Day](#), etc.) recognition benefits will be provided.

 - Presentation must take place prior to June 30, 2025.

Alternatively, if the sponsor registers a Walk team with the same name as the sponsor, AFSP will provide sponsor with a team tent with signage at the D.C. Walk. Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

- Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding, later.
