 - Deadline to guarantee benefits for all NCAC OOTD Community Walks is August 23, 2024. Deadline to have logo

- Benefit Promotional tent OR sponsorship of event area at Walk

 - Sponsor must notify Kelly Mahoney at kmahoney@afsp.org of intent for redemption at least 10 business days prior to the Walk to receive benefit.
 - If sponsor chooses the "promotional tent" option (not available for the D.C. Walk): AFSP will provide one tent, two tables and two chairs. Sponsor must provide all other materials.
 - If sponsor chooses the "sponsorship of event area" option: sponsor will work with NCAC to determine through which Walk event area (e.g. Loss & Healing Activity, Team Photo Area, etc.) recognition benefits will be provided. AFSP will provide sponsor signage for at that area.
 - The U.S. National Park Service does not permit sponsor promotional tents at the D.C. Walk. Therefore, only the "sponsorship of event area at Walk" benefit is available for that Walk event.
