

Community Emergency Vehicles Deliver Lifesaving Blood When Patients Need It Most

Every day, the Red Cross hosts more than 500 blood drives nationwide.



Dodge ProMaster 3500 | Gift of \$45,000

- These vehicles transport specialized equipment and critical supplies—such as donor beds, phlebotomist materials and blood donation supplies—to blood drives held at community locations.
- Vehicles also transport blood from community mobile drives back to Red Cross processing, testing and storage facilities.
- After more than three years of non-stop blood and equipment transportation, these vehicles are tuned-up and refitted for Disaster Relief work.



Chrysler Voyager | Gift of \$32,000

- These vehicles transport skilled staff and volunteers to and from blood drives across the community.
- They are also used to transport lifesaving blood from distribution centers and deliver it to patients in need at hospitals and cancer treatment centers.
- Vehicles also provide emergency delivery of rare blood and urgent blood to hospitals experiencing a shortage.



Ford Transit Connect | Gift of \$30,000

- These vehicles transport blood from processing, testing and storage centers and deliver it to patients in need at hospitals and cancer treatment centers.

- These vehicles transport skilled staff and volunteers to and from blood drives across the community.
