- Every registered participant also receives a t-shirt. If you registered by November 17, your shirts will be coming directly to you in the mail. If you registered after that date, we will have t-shirts at the event.
- This event is very festive, so feel free to break out your holiday wear and have some fun! We will have jingle bells available to tie on your shoes and will have a human and pet costume contest!
