By supporting the Walk to Cure Arthritis, you are doing more than participating in the largest arthritis gathering in the world, but you are making a difference to the **one in four people (54 million Americans), including 300,000 kids**, in your community living with the debilitating effects of arthritis every day. Through this support you are **helping to provide valuable support** to the arthritis community. In 2020 alone, Arthritis Foundation provided support through:

- Hosted Juvenile Arthritis camp virtually with nearly 1,000 campers attending virtual and recorded sessions.
- Personal support calls were made to 6,200 people with arthritis.
- Our 186 peer-led Connect Groups 26% of which have been established since the pandemic started have held over 340 virtual events attended by 900 people.
- Pivoted our first annual OA Clinical Studies Conference to a virtual format and added five pre-conference sessions on topic-specific issues, including Cell Therapy, Biologics and Emerging Therapies, which have been attended by nearly 500 people



Moderately strong pain. It can't be ignored for more than a few minutes, but with effort you still can manage to work or participate in some social activities.*

Arthritis affects **25%** of the population in Georgia. That is **1,890,000** adults living with doctor-diagnosed arthritis in the state. **1 in 3** veterans has arthritis, which accounts for **16.8%** of the people in Georgia living with arthritis. There are approximately **300,000 kids** with arthritis in the U.S. Approximately **10,000** live in Georgia.
