- All day-of registering participants must register on site at the event for a fee of \$50 and a fundraising minimum of \$250 by June 30 for anyone 18+ years old

Spectator/Community Festival Check In: Check in is open from 8:30 am - 12:00 pm

- Pay onsite (Cash, Check, or Credit Card)
- Entry fee is \$20 per person, must pick up wristband before entering Community Festival

All registered participants are invited to join us for food and beverages, fun activities, a sponsor pavilion, music, and more!

The Community Festival is open from 10:00 am – 1:00 pm.

Entry to the Festival is included for registered participants of the Bike and Fun Run events. Family members and friends who would like to attend the festival, but are not registered to participate in the bike event or 5K Fun Run, can pay a \$20 entry fee at the door. Fee will also include lunch.







BIKE AND RUN/WALK ROUTES

distance distance for Autism BIKE EVENT + 5K FUN RUN
PRESENTED BY RAMSEY ARTS EAST

Riders can choose from -3, -10, or -15 mile routes. Please make sure the distance is appropriate for your skill and fitness level. Mileage is approximate.

10 and 15 Mile Ride

The routes are mainly flat with little elevation gain. They travel though the quaint borough of HoHoKus in addition to Ridgewood and Paramus. Suitable for all levels of rider.

View 15 Mile Ride View 10 Mile Ride

3 Mile Ride

A very family-friendly ride that encompasses the residential neighborhood adjacent to Bergen Community College Campus.

View 3 Mile Ride

5K Fun Run/Walk

The fun run/walk uses the paths and roadway within the Bergen Community College campus. Participants can choose to complete 1 lap (1.1 miles), 2 laps (2.2miles), or 3 laps (approximately 5k/3.3 miles). Note: this is not a certified course.

View 5K Fun Run/Walk 1 mile loop

IMPORTANT RIDE INFORMATION

The SAG and Event Contact # is 984-260-8589. You can call or text but please be patient as it may take the vehicle a little time to get to your location.

In the case of a serious injury or emergency please dial 911 first.



We do recommend you carry your cell phone with you in case of emergency or if you need of SAG support. If you must use your cell phone, we ask that you stop safely on the side of the road to do so.

CYCLING RULES OF THE ROAD

Ride safe - You must wear a helmet secured to your chin at all times.

Follow the law - Your safety and the safety of others depend on you. You have the same rights and duties as drivers. Obey traffic signals and stop signs. Ride with traffic; use the rightmost lane headed in the direction you are going. Use the designated bike lanes where possible.

Be predictable - Make your intentions clear to motorists and other road users. Ride in a straight line and don't swerve between parked cars. Signal turns and check behind you well before turning or changing lanes.

Be conspicuous - Ride where drivers can see you; wear bright clothing. Use a front and/or rear blinking lite. It's the law. Make eye contact with drivers. Don't ride on sidewalks.

Pay attention - For your safety and the safety of your fellow participants we ask that you do not use headphones (including Bluetooth), iPod, selfie sticks, cell phones, or other such devices.

Think ahead - Anticipate what drivers, pedestrians, and other bicyclists will do next. Watch for turning vehicles and ride outside the door zone of parked cars. Look out for debris, potholes, and utility covers. Cross railroad tracks at right angles.

Be considerate - Please do not litter.

Ride ready - Check your tires have sufficient air, brakes are working, chain runs smoothly, and quick release wheel levers are closed. Carry repair and emergency supplies appropriate for your ride.



GTD Frequently Asked Questions

Are strollers allowed?

Strollers are allowed in the 5k fun run/walk and will start at the back when the 5k begins. We ask that all participants with strollers are mindful of people who may be running and walking around and behind them.

Are dogs allowed?

Service animals are welcome. In accordance with Bergen Community College rules, all other animals will not be allowed at this event.

What type of bike is allowed on the bike routes?

Bikes must be in good condition with working brakes. No recumbent bikes or bike attachments for children will be allowed. Children between the ages of 2 and 5 years of age will are permitted to ride in a children's bike carrier. If you are looking to rent a bike for this event please see page 9.

I am coming to support a family member who is participating. Is there anything at this event for me?

Yes! We welcome supporters. Spectators can pay a \$20 fee at the door which will include entry into the Community Festival and lunch.

What should I pack?

Go the Distance is a rain or shine event! Be sure to check the weather to decide how to appropriately dress and pack for the day. We suggest you bring:

- ID (in a plastic baggie or other protective material)
- Sunscreen
- Helmet unless you are renting on site
- Rain jacket (just in case)
- Water bottle (to stay hydrated)
- Snack (if you have dietary restrictions)
- Strollers are welcome on 5k route

Directions Via Route 17 from the North


• Turn Right off Route 17 onto Ridgewood Avenue (west) to Paramus Road. Turn Left onto Paramus Road and continue approximately two miles to college. Proceed around jug handle to main entrance.

Directions Via Route 17 from the South

- Take Century Road, second exit to the right. Proceed around cloverleaf over Route 17 onto Century Road (west). Continue to Paramus Road. Turn right onto Paramus Road and follow to the college entrance on the right.
- Go the Distance directional signs will be placed around the campus grounds to guide drivers.
 - Parking for Riders, Volunteers and Community Festival guests is located in Event Parking Lot A, Surface Lot and Parking Deck and in Event Parking Lot C.
- Handicap Parking is available in Lot C. Follow signs for handicap parking.
