

SIGN LANGUAGE ABC'S





Recettes

GLACE A LA MAISON

Utilisez les instructions ci-dessous pour faire de la glace maison

- **1 1/2 tasses de demi et demi creme**
 - **1 cuillere a soupe de sucre**
 - **1/4 cuillere a cafe de vanille**
 - **1/2 tasse de sel**
 - **3 tasse de glace**
 - **1 sac de taille gallon**
 - **1 pinte taille sac**
 - **Torchon**

Directions

Commencez par remplir le sac zip-top de la taille d'un gallon avec la moitié de la glace. Saupoudrer la moitié du sel gemme sur la glace et ensuite placer le sac zip-top pinte taille à l'intérieur. Maintenant, mesurez soigneusement et versez la moitié et la moitié dans le petit sac de pinte avec la vanille et le sucre. Assurez-vous que le haut est hermétiquement fermé!

Emballez le reste de la glace autour du sac rempli de crème, puis saupoudrer avec le reste du sel gemme. Zip le haut, envelopper dans le torchon, et préparez-vous à trembler.

Secouez! Le point de congélation de l'eau salée est plus bas que l'eau ordinaire, donc ajouter tout ce sel est une partie essentielle du traitement à froid! Optez pour deux minutes de bonne agitation. Crème glacée crémeuse devrait attendre à l'intérieur! Retirez la crème glacée du sac de glace salée et dégustez - directement du sac.



