> In 2019, at the age of 17, Haoyu was diagnosed with leukemia and received his treatment at the Montreal Children's Hospital. When Haoyu found out he was eligible for a wish, he did not hesitate as to what he wanted.

> Last October, Haoyu was able to safely give 5 tablets with accessories and 1 UVC sterilizer to Josée Della Rocca, Director of Partnerships at the Montreal Children's Hospital Foundation, who received them on behalf of the hospital and oncology patients. These tablets will allow the children to entertain themselves and feel connected to the outside world throughout their treatment and also help specialized educators to do virtual activities simultaneously with patients on the care unit and in the clinic.

Recalling from my experience, the greatest challenge was to stay positive and not to give up hope. Having a way to communicate with the outside world was the main thing that kept me occupied and happy while confined in a small room."



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
