Get The Word Out



Personal Donation

Making a personal donation not only kick starts your fundraising and helps you get closer to your goal, but it shows your potential donors your commitment to the cause.



- Make sure information is trickling down to your team members (fundraising ideas, contests, deadlines, etc.) and ask them if they need any support with their fundraising.
- ☆ Incentivize your team members by having a team BBQ or draw a prize for the member with the most donations collected.
- ☆ Don't forget to mention and give your team members a shout out when they've reached their goal. It helps motivate other team members.



Most important tip, follow up: It has been proven

that it takes

at least 4 follow-ups

with donors to get the donation. Don't be shy, you are asking for a good cause! Some people need more than one email or call and will

appreciate the reminder.

Social Tools

- Typodate your social media cover photos to let your networks know what you're doing to help make wishes come true.
- Add our image to your email signature and link it to your personal fundraising page so donors can easily make a donation and read all about your challenge.
- ☆ On virtual calls all day? Time to change your background to spark up a conversation.

Create Incentives For Your Donors

- For example, baking your donors a dozen cookies for each donation they give you, or letting them chose a funny costume for you to wear on your next run.

- Host a games night, organize a raffle, or ask your entourage to make a donation in lieu of gifts for your birthday.
