
RIDER PACKET:

IDENTIFICATION PLACEMENT:

IN YOUR RIDER PACKET YOU WILL RECEIVE SEVERAL IMPORTANT ITEMS AS INDICATED BELOW.



1. BIB NUMBER--You must wear your bib number while on the route and at the start and finish lines. Please use safety pins to pin it to the back of you outer-most layer of clothing.

2. FRAME NUMBERS--Attach to your bike (underneath your seat) or fold over your bike frame and attach with twist ties. Your frame number will be verified with your bib number when picking up your bike from bike lock up in Lawrence.

LUGGAGE TAGS--Cyclists are allowed two piece of luggage each. Please put your luggage tag on both pieces of luggage handles before dropping off at Luggage Truck Saturday morning.

BIKE MS RELEASE AND WAIVER--This document reinforces cycling etiquette and common rules of the road. It is required that you sign the waiver agreeing to abide by these policies in order to receive your rider packet. If your packet is to be picked up by someone else, **YOU MUST** submit in advance the completed form or provide the individual with your completed form to turn in on your behalf. A completed form is required in order for your packet to be released; **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

RIDER HELPLINE--The rider helpline will be located on the front of your bib below your rider number. Please call this number on route if you need assistance ride weekend.

EMERGENCY INFORMATION--on the back of all bibs will be an area to put down your emergency contact. **YOU MUST** fill out the emergency information prior to our ride.
