#### LODGING

#### FOR THE GETAWAY PACKAGE (2-NIGHTS STAY):




#### **FESTIVE BANQUET**





## Roadside assistance and support

A team of certified cycling escorts trained in first aid and able to perform minor mechanical repairs will be riding along with you. If you need help, we can assist with motor vehicles at any time.

## Respect the rules of the road and other road users

- → Ride on the right-hand side of the road and in single file (groups must not exceed 15 people)
- → Signal your intentions.
- → Remember that it takes longer to come to a stop when braking in rainy conditions

# GENERAL INFORMATION



#### Plan your trip. Keep with you at all time:

- → A water bottle to fill (there will be water stations in several spots along the way)
- → Cash or a credit card, your health insurance card and your cell phone
- → Sportswear: bike shorts and a jersey, loose-fitting or soft clothing, bicycle helmet
- → Sneakers or cycling shoes, preferably with a rigid sole
- → A bike tire repair kit (inner tube, tire wrenches and bike pump)
- → Sunscreen, a rain jacket and pants, shoe covers, etc.



#### Make sure your bike is in good condition

- → Adjusted brakes and derailleur gears
- → Lubricated chain
- → Sufficiently inflated tires
- → Accessories securely attached to the frame (water bottle holder, rack, etc.)
