



1. What is NAMIWalks Broward County?

NAMIWalks Broward County is an annual walkathon that raises awareness and funds for the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) Broward County. The event brings together individuals, families, and communities to support mental health education, advocacy, and services.

2. When and where does the walk take place?

When: Saturday, October 5, 2024 from 8am - 12pm

Where: NOVA Southeastern University (the lawn in front of the Alvin Sherman Library)

3. How do I register for NAMIWalks Broward County?

You can register online at <https://www.namiwalks.org/browardcounty>. Simply visit the registration page, fill out the required information, and you're all set! Registration is free, but fundraising is encouraged.

4. Is there a registration fee?

There is no registration fee to participate. However, participants are encouraged to raise funds to support NAMI's mission.

5. How do I create or join a team?

During the registration process, you have the option to start your own team or join an existing one. Team captains can invite others to join and work together to raise funds and awareness.

6. What should I bring to the walk?

Comfortable walking shoes, weather-appropriate clothing, sunscreen, water, and your enthusiasm! It's also a good idea to bring any materials or signs that show your support for mental health awareness.

7. Is the walk family-friendly?

Absolutely! NAMIWalks Broward County is a family-friendly event. People of all ages are welcome to join in the fun and show their support for mental health.

8. How do I donate to a walker or team?

You can donate directly through the website <https://www.namiwalks.org/browardcounty>. Search for the participant or team you want to support, and follow the prompts to make your donation.

9. What happens if it rains on the day of the walk?

The walk typically proceeds rain or shine, but in the case of severe weather, updates will be posted on the NAMI Broward County website and social media pages.

10. How are the funds raised used?

Funds raised support local programs and services, including educational resources, support groups, advocacy efforts, and outreach programs that help individuals and families affected by mental illness.

11. Can we register on walk day?

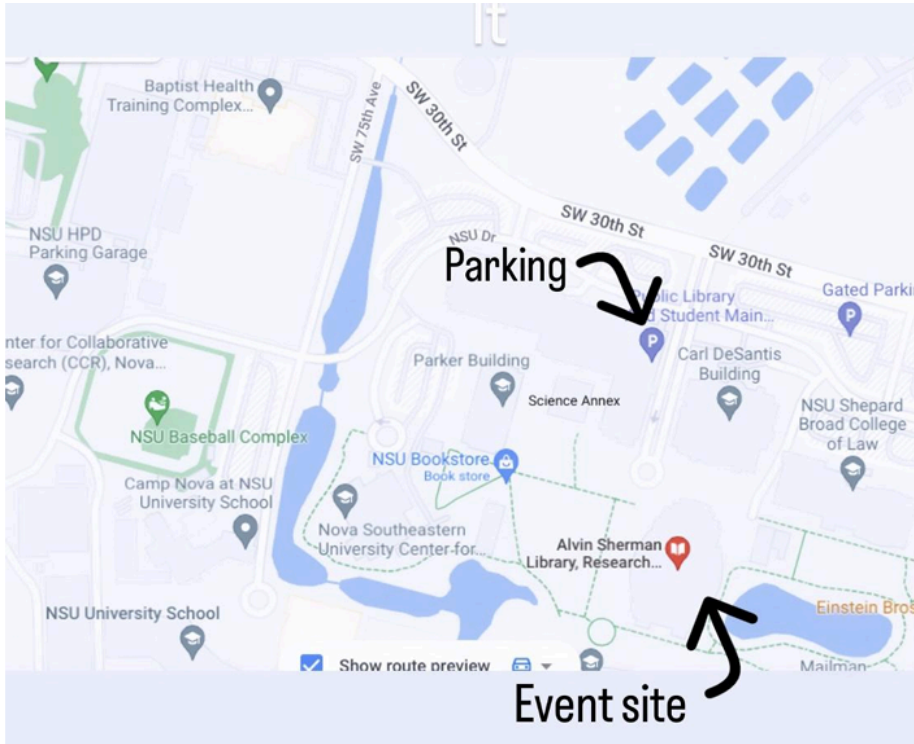
Yes! Although we encourage pre-registration online whenever possible, you are welcome to show up on walk day and register onsite. Visit the registration tent immediately upon arrival.

12. How do we get there?

- From University Drive, also called SR 817
- Traveling on University Drive, go east onto SW 30th Street/Abe Fischler Blvd
- Drive east past the Baptist Health Training Facility, turn right at the NSU North Campus entrance onto Ray Ferrero Jr. Blvd.
- The Alvin Sherman Library parking garage will be on the right

13. Where should we park?

14. How do we get event t-shirts?
