Over one million Americans are living with Parkinson's disease. More than seventeen thousand of them live in Colorado and Wyoming.

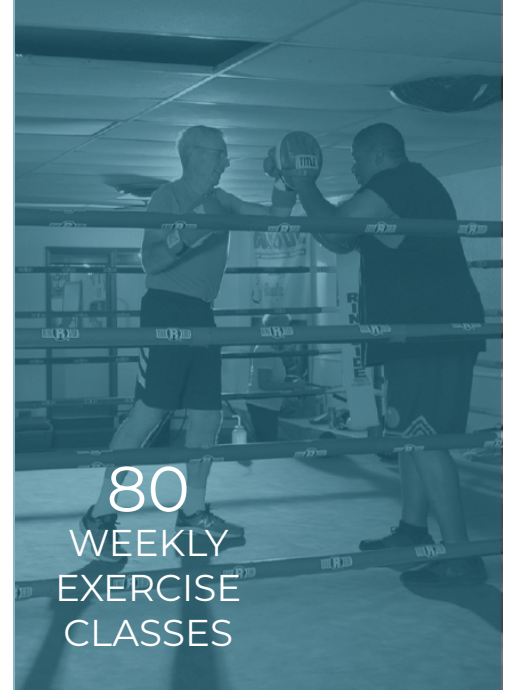
Parkinson's is one of the most common neurological diseases; second only to Alzheimer's. It is a progressive and debilitating disease that has significant social and financial effects.

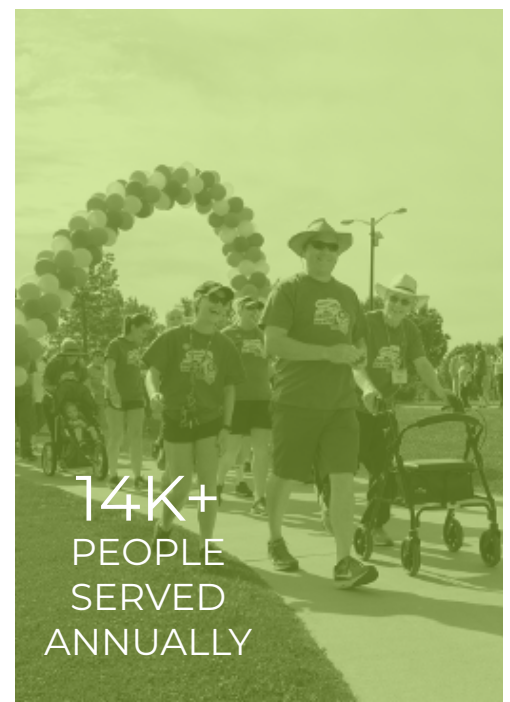
