Sadly, SUD is devastating our country at an increasing rate. Exacerbated by the pandemic and declining mental health, we now have a record number of people in our country struggling with SUD. Additionally, fentanyl is pervasive across all substance use and increasing the overdose rates in our country. We suffered an all-time high of more than 107,000 overdose deaths in 2021, with 2/3 of the increase from fentanyl. There were an additional 100,000 deaths from alcohol use disorder. While the impact of SUD is felt regardless of race, ethnicity, class, or socioeconomic status, the disease impacts communities of color more intensely. We cannot wait to effect this change. Eleven people die every hour from an overdose; we must do everything possible to stop this.
