What is the Shatterproof Walk to End Addiction Stigma?

The Shatterproof Walk is an opportunity for people to gather without the stigma or judgement of addiction. Surrounded by friends, family, and loved ones, our community creates a national support system for people impacted by substance use.

Is registration required to participate?

Everyone is welcome to join us for walk day, but we encourage you to [register here](#) so that you don't miss out on all pre-event communications, updates, and fun opportunities! Registration is free!

Is fundraising required to participate?

You do not need to fundraise to participate in the Shatterproof Walk to End Addiction Stigma. For those who do fundraise, all money raised supports Shatterproof's mission and expands our efforts to support the prevention, treatment, & recovery of addiction. How do I get to the LA Shatterproof Walk to End Addiction Stigma?

Parking: Parking is available in Lot 10 on N Broadway between First Street and Temple Street. Parking lot has entrances on N. Broadway and on N. Hill St.

Public Transportation: Take the Metro Red or Purple Line to Civic Center/Grand Park Station or the Gold Line to Union Station or Little Tokyo/Arts District Station.

Driving Directions: Best GPS Address to use: 145 N Broadway, Los Angeles, CA 90012

Drop Off: Grand Park Event Lawn – Block 4 (200 N Grand Ave, Los Angeles, CA 90012)

Is this event dog friendly?

Yes! Dogs are allowed as long as they are kept on a leash.

Is the Walk Route wheelchair and stroller friendly?

What time should I plan to arrive?

Our event site opens at 8 AM and we encourage you to come right on time! You will start with registration and/or check-in for those who are already registered. This is where you can pick up your fundraising incentives, purchase a 2024 Walk T-Shirt if you don't have one already, and get all your information for the day!

After that, head to the **Together with You** wall to share why you walk with Shatterproof and pick up your bracelet, which you will need for the Official Walk Program that starts promptly at 9:30am!

From there, we have designated space for those who are celebrating recovery to create their own wearable to celebrate their journey. We also have a designated space for those walking in memory of a lost loved one, if you would like to have a photo printed to wear on walk day to honor their memory, [please upload it here](#) (pin is 3599).

Finally, we will have our Community Resource Village up and running for you to meet local organizations supporting Shatterproof's mission, and the Shatterproof and You tent, where you can learn more about our work and meet our staff!

I heard there were bracelets. What are those about?

See the Shatterproof community come to life like never before! All Walk attendees are invited to stop by the Together with You area where you can pick up the color bracelet that best reflects your connection to our mission:

- White Bracelet: Lost someone to substance use disorder/addiction
- Teal Bracelet: Living in recovery
- Purple Bracelet: Member of the community who is ready to end stigma and save lives
- Navy Bracelet: Love someone living with substance use disorder/addiction

How Can I get a Walk T-Shirt?

This year, Shatterproof launched an early-bird registration for all in-person walks. Participants who registered on or before July 12 could start their fundraising with a \$35 self-donation that also guaranteed a 2024 Walk T-shirt.

For participants who opted into this opportunity, your Walk T-shirt will arrive at the address you provided at the time of registration before the end of September.

For anyone who was not able to opt in to this early bird registration opportunity, a limited number of Walk T-shirts will be available for purchase on-site on Walk Day for \$45 at the Registration and Check-In Area.
