1. Agreement. The undersigned agrees to serve as a chaperone for the Sleep Out event taking place on March 15-16, 2024 in the Jacob Javits Center in New York, NY (the "Event") pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

2. Criteria for Adult Chaperone. I confirm that I am a qualified, adult chaperone. A qualified, adult chaperone is any individual that is: (i) at least 21 years of age, (ii) a parent or legal guardian or teacher of the child's participating school or program, and (iii) is not employed by Covenant House, Covenant House New York or Covenant House New Jersey. I understand that although Covenant House has the right to solely rely on my representation, I may be asked to provide documentation to confirm my qualifications on or before the Event date.

3. Appointment and Acceptance. I have been appointed to serve as a chaperone for the child(ren) named below and hereby accept the appointment. I have the right to revoke this acceptance on or before March 15, 2024. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in order for my revocation to be effective, I must inform Covenant House, in writing, of my revocation on or before the Event date.

4. Chaperone Policies. I hereby agree to adhere to all Sleep Out policies including but not limited to the following Chaperone Policies:

- Chaperones are only permitted to serve as a chaperone for up to eight children.
- Chaperones must remain at the event for the duration of the Sleep Out. Chaperone must be present with the youth they are chaperoning at all times.
- Chaperones are responsible for youth behavior, and must ensure that youth adhere to all policies of Sleep Out.
- Chaperones must have a list of emergency contacts available for all youth attending the Sleep Out.
- If a youth needs to leave for any reason, the chaperone must contact and coordinate with a parent or guardian and ensure the youth leaves safely with a parent or guardian.
