HOW TO USE DONORDRIVE'S FUNDRAISING PORTAL TO BE A SUCCESSFUL FUNDRAISER



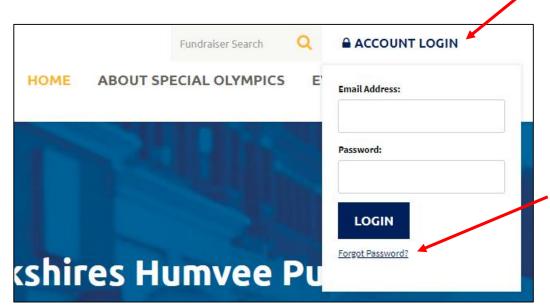
Tips for Success

Thank you for fundraising for Special Olympics Massachusetts! Your efforts make a difference to our organization. We hope the tools available to you will help you succeed. Start with these Best Practices.

- 1. **Donate to yourself.** This sets the tone and shows that you are dedicated.
- 2. **Personalize your fundraising page.** Upload a photo, highlight your connection to Special Olympics, and set your fundraising goal, all from the Dashboard.
- 3. **Start asking right away.** The earlier you begin fundraising, the more you will raise. Use the email tool to send and track messages.
- 4. **Share your page on social media.** Take advantage of the sharing power of social media to help you reach more people, and include the link to your fundraising page.
- 5. **Say thank you.** When a friend supports you, send a thank-you note right from your Messages area.



Your Fundraising Account



When you log in, you'll be able to personalize your fundraising page, send emails to friends, spread the word using social media, and track donations made toward your fundraising goal.

Log in using the email address and password you used when you registered for the event.

Forgot your password? Click the Forgot Password link to reset your password. There can be up to a 15 minute delay between clicking this link and receiving the email.

Note: The link you receive to reset your password can only be clicked once. You can get another link by clicking Forgot Password again. Every time the Forgot Password email is sent, the prior link becomes inactive.





Event Landing Page

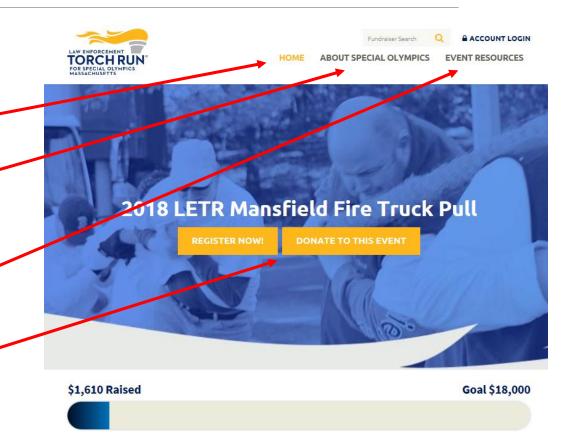
Here you will find the landing page to your fundraiser. Each event looks different, so this is just a general layout.

Home: brings you back to the homepage for the event

About Special Olympics: find information about special Olympics, our social media links, our financial report, and information about Xtra Mile or LETR.

Event Resources: Find toolkits, sponsorship, this user guide, and volunteering information.

Register Now and Donate Buttons: Use these tools to be directed to the registration page and to donate to a participant.

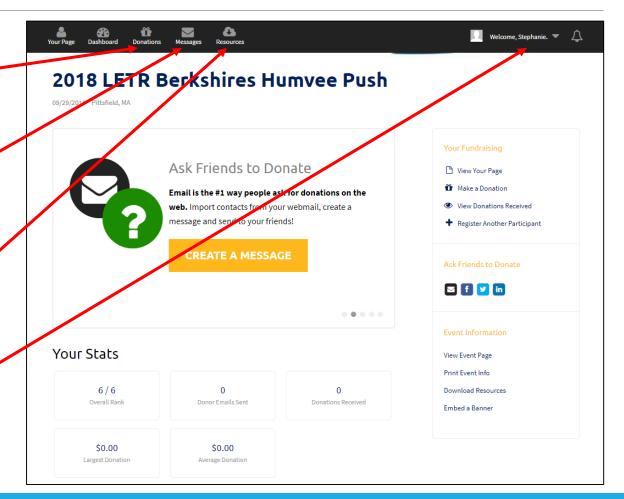

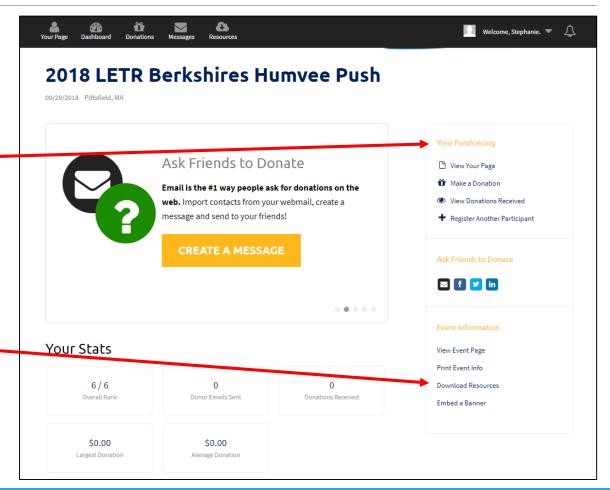
Welcome to your Dashboard

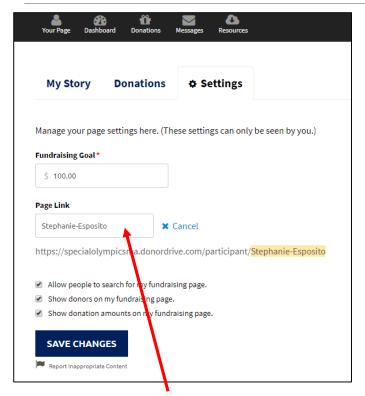
Event Information:

Click **Download Resources** to find race maps, registration, and event specific details.

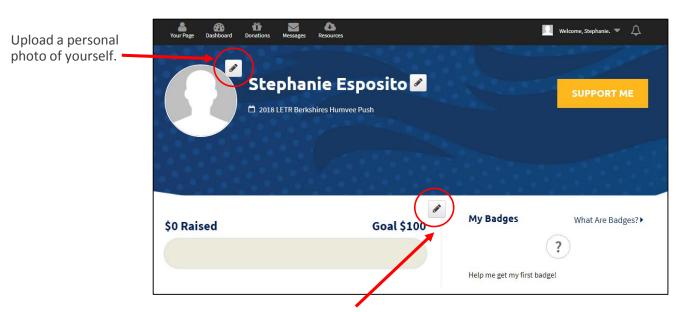

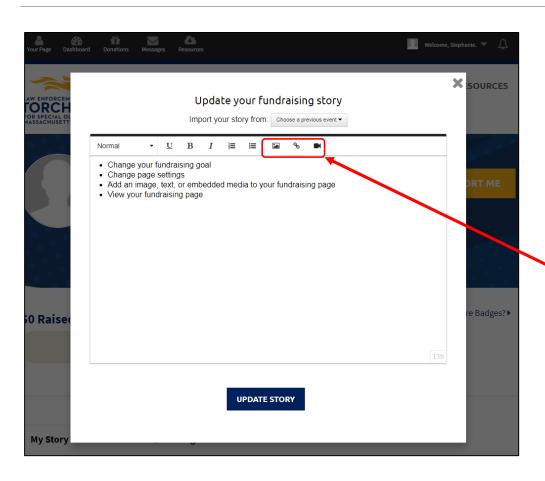
Create an easy-to-remember link for your fundraising page.

Embed photos, web links, and videos to enhance your story.





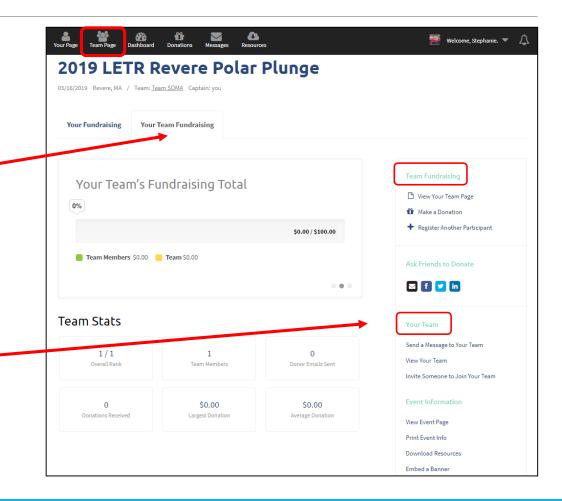
For Team Captains

Your Team Fundraising:

If you're a team captain, you'll see an additional link on your dashboard – **Your Team Fundraising**. Click this link for access to your team fundraising page, which can be updated similarly to your personal fundraising page.

Your Team:

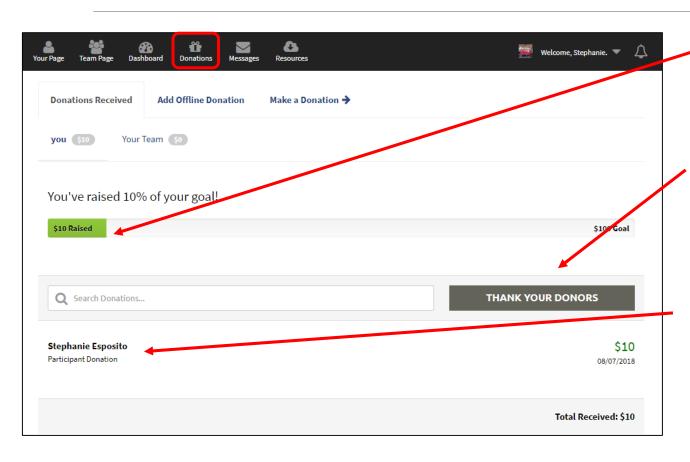
This section allows you to send messages to your teammates, view your team, and invite others to join your team.







Track Donations & Send Emails



Use the **Search** function to look for specific donors and amounts.

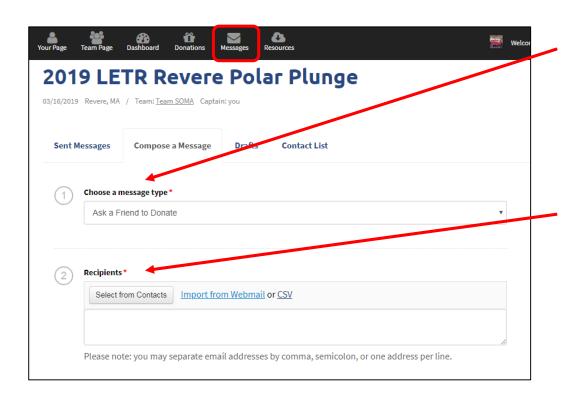
Click the **Thank Your Donors** button to send Thank You notes to donors you haven't thanked yet.

When you **click a donation**, a pop-up will appear that provides the donor's information*.

*Some donors may choose to remain anonymous and hide their email address.



Sending Emails



Message Type:

Choose from preset templates such as "Ask a friend to donate," "Ask a friend to join" and more.

*Note: If you want to send a different message, simply select any message type and change the email in the Message box below.

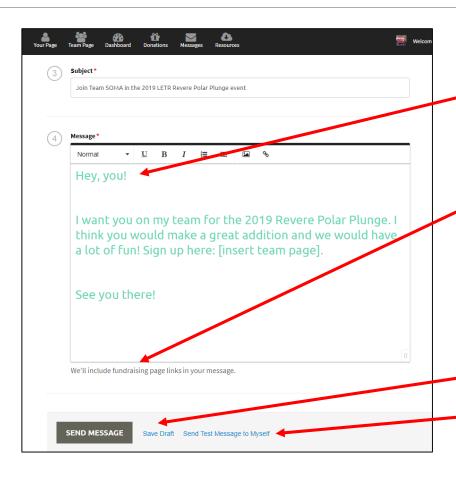
Recipients:

Choose people to receive your message. You can...

- Select from contacts you've already uploaded into your Contact List
- Select contacts who have responded to you by donating or joining your team
- Select contacts who haven't responded
- Import contacts from webmail like Gmail, Outlook, etc.
- Import a .CSV file



Sending Emails



Edit Your Message:

Add, delete, and edit text; add links; and format just like in other email programs.

*Note: A link back to your fundraising page will automatically be included in each email that you send out.

Saving and Sending Your Message:

You can:

- Save a draft that you can come back to later
- Send a test message to yourself and see what it will look like



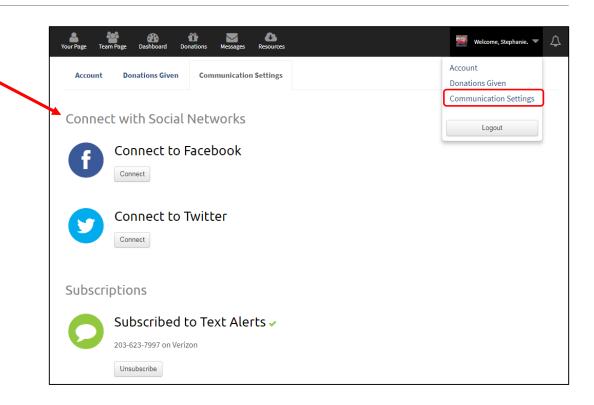


Connect Your Social Networks

Make sharing updates on social media easier and more effective.

Connecting to **Facebook** facilitates quicker posting.

Connecting your **Twitter** account allows for automatically tweeted updates, for example, when you receive a donation, or reach your fundraising goal.





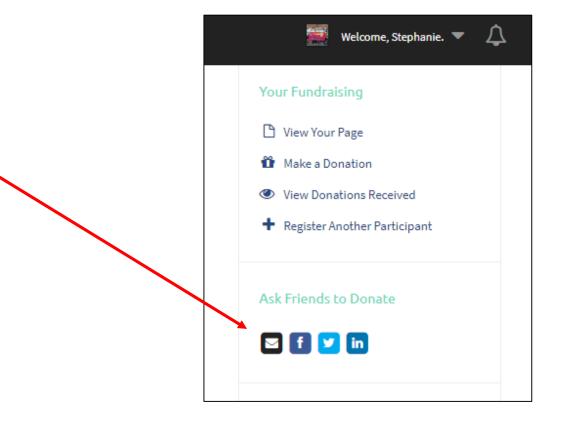
Share on Social Media

Spread the Word: Use these tools to share with friends and family, keep followers updated on your progress, and ask supporters to help you spread the word.

Facebook: Post an update that will appear in your friends' newsfeeds. A link back to your fundraising page will be automatically included in your post.

Twitter: Tweet to your followers

LinkedIn: Post an update that will appear in your connections' newsfeeds. A link back to your fundraising page will be included in your post.
