

- New technology and a better understanding of genetics has allowed researchers to **individualize therapies**, leading to personalized treatments and more survivors.
- There are 18 million cancer survivors in the U.S. today. That number is expected to rise to 22.5 million by 2032.
- The cancer death rate in the U. S. for men and women combined **fell 33%** from its peak in 1991. This translates to **3.8 million** fewer cancer deaths during these years.
- Over next decade, the number of people who have lived 5 or more years after their cancer diagnosis is projected to increase by approximately 30% to 16.3 million







The V Foundation invites each of the 71+ NATIONAL CANCER INSTITUTE-DESIGNATED CANCER FACILITIES to nominate researchers

for funding consideration.

The V Foundation's SCIENTIFIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE and ad hoc expert reviewers evaluate and recommend the best proposals for funding.
